**How to Get Here:** The Club is located in the community of Varsity Estates. Head north on Crowchild and take the 53rd Street exit. Follow 53rd street then turn right onto Varsity Estates Drive NW. Continue on Varsity Estates Drive NW—the entrance to Silver Springs Golf & Country Club will be on your right.

## **UPON ARRIVAL**

If you are golfing, upon arrival, **please drop your golf clubs at the bag drop located directly in front of the Club**. One of our Back Shop attendants will be pleased to help you. Once you have **checked in at the Pro Shop**, a member of our staff will be more than happy to assist you.

## **CLUB DRESS CODE**

Appropriate golf attire is required on the course and practice facilities. The Club's professional staff have been instructed to enforce the guidelines as set by the Board.

**Etiquette also applies, including gentlemen removing their hats in the Clubhouse.** Denim of any color is allowed in selected areas (specifically the Clubhouse) but not on the golf course or practice facilities, except for Stampede week.

#### **)** PERMITTED ATTIRE:

- **Golf Attire:** Golf-specific wear sold in our Pro Shop is always appropriate.
- **Men's Shirts:** Must have a collar and sleeves; tailored mock necks are acceptable.
- Men's Shorts and Pants: Shorts and pants must be tailored.
- Women's Shirts and Pants: Must have either a collar or sleeves; mock styles and v-necks are allowed. Tailored shorts, pants, slacks, capris, skorts, and dresses are all acceptable.
- **Hats/Visors:** Please wear them forward at all times on the golf course.

#### **NOT PERMITTED:**

- **Shorts:** No beach, gym, cut-off, cycling, tennis, or spandex styles.
- **Pants:** No tracksuits, leggings, spandex, or sweatpants.
- **Tops:** No tank tops, halter tops, mesh, or workout attire. Shirts should cover the midriff.
- **Offensive Language:** Clothing with offensive language or slogans is prohibited.
- Hats: Men must remove their hats while in the Clubhouse.







## **GUEST FEES AND CART RENTALS**

Guest Fee: (18 holes): \$130.00 Guest Fee (9 holes): \$90.00 Cart Seat (18 holes): \$24.00 Cart Seat (9 holes): \$15.00 TaylorMade Rental Clubs are available: Please contact the Pro Shop in advance to get set up.

## **SPEAKERS AND CELL PHONE USAGE**

To maintain the Club's peaceful atmosphere, we ask that **cell phones be set to silent or vibrate mode at all times**. Texting and emailing are welcome, but <u>please be mindful of</u> <u>those around you.</u>

If you choose to listen to music on the course, **Bluetooth speakers may be used at a respectful volume. If another group can hear your music, we kindly ask that you turn it down or off.** To preserve the Club's ambiance, speakers are not permitted in the Clubhouse or other common areas.

## **DRIVING RANGE ETIQUETTE**

The driving range is a valued service for members and their guests, regulated by Golf Shop management. Children under 7 are not permitted to use the range. We have many homes that are behind the driving range, as well as Hole #1 to the left, and we must be respectful of our neighbours. Please be respectful when practicing.

Players who can drive the ball over the back fence, or beyond the designated range boundaries (+ 280 yards), are prohibited from using their driver or any club that may exceed these limits. Violating this policy may result in immediate loss of range privileges.







### PACE OF PLAY

The recommended time for completion of 18 holes is <u>**4 hours or less**</u> from 1st tee starts and <u>**a**</u> <u>**round exceeding 4 hours and 18 minutes is deemed unacceptable.**</u> The following is deemed a violation of the place of play policy:

Any group whose pace of play exceeds 4 hours and 18 minutes from a first tee start, where the group finishes the round more than 10 minutes after the group immediately in front.

# All members on the course should be "in position" at all times. If a group is out of position, all three of the following are occurring:

- 1. One full hole behind the group in front of them (par 3 or par 4)
- 2.10 minutes off the expected time chart to that point on the course (averaging more than 14 minutes per hole)
- 3. Holding up the group behind them.

## **COURSE CARE AND ETIQUETTE**

We take immense pride in the exceptional condition of our golf course, thanks to the collective efforts of our members, guests, and staff. We kindly ask all guests to help by <u>repairing ball marks with a divot</u> <u>tool, raking bunkers after use, and filling divots</u> with the provided sand and seed mixture.

#### Cart paths should be used whenever possible,

especially near tees and greens. In areas where cart paths are unavailable, we encourage keeping carts on fairways rather than rough or fringe areas.
