HNT Services is just over two weeks into the 2025 Irrigation Project at Silver Springs and progress is being made every day.

## Hole #12 Update: 70% Complete

With helpful weather, contractors have been working diligently on hole #12 with mainline and river transfer line installation. Lateral lines down the fairway are installed and sprinkler heads

are wired and in the ground.

The putting green irrigation is operational on #12 green which allows the Turf Care team to keep the green watered and healthy for when the hole re-opens for play. The remaining work on #12 is the installation of pipes and sprinklers around the teeing area and the mainline coming out of the pumphouse. HNT Services will continue progressing this week and into the weekend.



## **Driving Range Update:**

The driving range irrigation is complete, tied in, and will be tested this week. Contractors will ensure proper operation of all sprinkler heads, including backfilling, leveling, flushing of debris and final sod work/trench work clean up. A walk through WITH HNT Services and Lance Morris, Golf Course Superintendent, will be done to ensure quality and address any deficiencies.

Please remember the golf course is considered a construction site. Remember to obey all directional signage when entering a hole under construction for your safety. Do not approach heavy equipment or irrigation contractors if they are using machinery as they may not see or hear you approach.

We will continue to keep you informed about the irrigation renovation as it progresses week-to-week. As contractors near the completion of hole #12, communication will be sent out about the next hole that will be under construction and out of play. Please note the signage at the Pro Shop, First Tee, and on the golf course for hole closures and where to proceed.

Thank you for your understanding and support as we navigate through the Project in 2025. It is our goal to make your experience at Silver Springs positive, engaging and most of all, FUN!
